Industry Sector: Health

Participating School Districts: Canal Winchester Local Schools, Columbus City Schools, Gahanna-Jefferson Public Schools, Licking Heights Local Schools, Marysville Exempted Village, New Albany-Plain Local Schools, Pickerington Local Schools, Reynoldsburg City Schools and Westerville City Schools

Industry Partners: OhioHealth, Mount Carmel, Nationwide Children's Hospital, BioOhio, Westerville Chamber of Commerce, Diley Ridge Medical Center and PharmaForce

- This pathway is a collaborative initiative with nine school districts, Columbus State Community College and numerous industry partners. There are 12 listed certificates in the Health Career Pathway, along with the required Columbus State Community College credit hours needed to obtain each certificate.
- Each partnering district will customize its program, including which certifications will be offered for students. Districts seeking common certifications will have the opportunity to collaborate with career and technical partners, Columbus State Community College, and participate in combined authentic work-based experiences.
- The program includes advanced distance learning labs capable of providing a variety of virtual instructional delivery models. Students participating in this pathway will earn marketable industry certification(s), as well as progression toward an associate and/or bachelor's degree.
